### CLASS DESCRIPTIONS: Session 2 (11/6/23 – 1/26/23)

#### **Arts and Crafts**

**(All Ages, Max 20)**

Join our creative counselors and your friends for a new art or craft project each week! Projects will be determined by age, using various media to imagine and construct projects that tap into your creative side and sharpen fine motor skills. **You may only register for one Arts and Crafts class per week.**

#### **Art with Nature**

**(All Ages, Max 15)**

We will be offering Under the Sea this session. An exploration of all things under water, from fish, to mermaids and coral reefs while using upcycled, donated and thrifted materials. Let's keep this stuff out of our oceans and find a fun and creative way to reuse it! *Class provided by CraftLab Seattle.* **You may only register for one Art with Nature class per week.**

#### **Basketball Games**

**(Classes split by K-2<sup>nd</sup> Grade and 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> Grade, Max 20)**

Have fun playing bump, around-the-world, P.I.G. and other classic basketball-type games with campers of all skill levels!

#### **Beginner Sewing**

**(3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> Grade, Max 12)**

Students will be introduced to the basics of sewing. They will learn how to thread a needle, knotting, basic stitches, attaching a button and will create a variety of super fun and creative projects and show off their skills. *Class provided by Kulsoom.*

#### **Chess Club**

**(K-2<sup>nd</sup> Grade, Max 20; 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> Grade, Max 25)**

Chess Club is a community for new and experienced students to learn and play together. We will review how to setup and play a game, checkmate patterns, chess tricks and traps (tactics), and how to start a game (openings). Participants will receive a ChessKid account to have 24/7 access to chess puzzles, lessons, and games! All students who train in Chess Club will automatically become student coaches for the following school year's Chess Club! *Class provided by Cary "Coach Ray" Easterday, Owner and Instructor, Orangutan Chess Academy.*

#### **Coding Kidz**

**(2<sup>nd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> Grade, Max 12)**

An introduction to basic coding for elementary-aged campers to learn computer science fundamentals through fun, engaging, and interactive online exercises and games. Students will complete a different "Hour of Code" activity from code.org each week. Campers will work at their own pace – both in class and at home – in code.org's Express or Pre-Reader Express course. This class will take place in the school computer lab, and students must be able to login to a school computer. Headphones recommended.

#### **Creative Writing**

**(2<sup>nd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> Grade, Max 8)**

An opportunity for kids to tell their own stories, campers will practice handwriting, spelling, and creative expression through crafting short stories, comics, and other forms of written word.

#### **Domino Toppling**

**(All Ages, Max 16)**

Learn the basics of constructing domino setups, including lines, curves, splits and spirals. Then move on to bridges, fields, and towers! During each class, we'll use videos (from Hevesh5 and Nathan's Dominoes, among others), books, and demonstrations to get ideas for mesmerizing tricks and physical feats. Along the way, we'll discuss techniques for dealing

with frustration and disappointment when a trick doesn't go as planned. ***This class is best for kiddos who are patient and focused, and who enjoy being engaged in STEM projects.***

### **Fiber Art Camp**

**(K-2<sup>nd</sup> Grade, Max 12)**

Students will be introduced to a variety of fiber art techniques and projects each week. They will learn basic Sewing and Weaving techniques and create a variety of projects using their newly learned skill. *Class provided by Kulsoom.*

### **Gaga Ball + HOF Games**

**(Classes split by K-2<sup>nd</sup> Grade and 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> Grade, Max 20)**

Can't get enough Gaga Ball? Play every week while mixing in some other summer camp favorites such as 9-Square, Castle Ball, and dodgeball games! Newcomers will learn the games and improve their skills, while seasoned players can get their competitive juices flowing. ***You may only register for one Gaga Ball class per day.***

### **Hip Hop Kids**

**(K-4<sup>th</sup> Grade, Max 10)**

Hip Hop Kids Dance Fitness classes (aka Hip Hop Kids) feature kid-friendly routines based on original hip hop and pop choreography. We break down the steps and add games and other activities into the class structure. Plenty of time to FREESTYLE too! Think of this class as a weekly after school DANCE PARTY! Hip Hop Kids helps to develop a healthy lifestyle and incorporate fitness as a natural part of children's lives by making fitness fun! Classes incorporate key childhood development elements like leadership, respect, teamwork, confidence, self-esteem, memory, creativity, coordination, and cultural awareness. *Class provided by Seattle Dance Fitness.*

### **Kids' Carpentry**

**(All Ages, Max 8)**

Kids' Carpentry is a hands-on toy building experience designed to teach kids ages practical woodworking skills with an emphasis on the safe use of hand tools. While kids construct fun and exciting projects they are also empowered to become independent thinkers- building confidence, self-esteem, and a repertoire of practical skills that will last them a lifetime. At the end of the session kids will bring home one or more wooden games or toys that they have built by hand from scratch. ***You may only register for one Carpentry class per week.*** *Class provided by Kids' Carpentry Seattle.*

### **Lego Mania!**

**(All Ages, Max 20)**

Let your imagination run wild with our growing collection of Legos! Each week, kids will choose a building challenge and also have time for their own free-build creations.

### **Parkour**

**(Classes split by K-2<sup>nd</sup> Grade and 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> Grade, Max 16)**

Get ready for an adventurous journey in Social Awareness, Relationships, and Responsible Decision-Making Skills. The Kong Academy program empowers kids physically, socially, and emotionally through: play, games, and parkour-based movement. Join us as your kids unlock their social superpowers through fitness-focused games and movement-based adventures. They'll dive into a world of teamwork, navigating challenges that foster social awareness and build positive relationships. *Class provided by Kong Academy.* ***You may only register for one Parkour class per week.***

### **Rainbow Loom**

**(All ages, Max 16)**

Spend the afternoon hanging out with friends, listening to music, and learning how to make a new bracelet each week. Campers will create and unwind with Rainbow Loom rubber bands in a relaxed environment, fostering creativity and fellowship.

### **Rhythm Circle**

**(2<sup>nd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> Grade, Max 12)**

Circle up around hand drums and other percussive instruments to jam out while learning the names, origins, and techniques of each of each. *Class provided by Mode Music and Performing Arts.*

### **Scene Study**

**(3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> Grade, Max 12)**

Students will analyze and act out selected scenes from books and tv series, with opportunities to create costumes, props, and set pieces for the final performance. This program teaches valuable theatre skills such as creative collaboration, memorization techniques, identifying objectives and motivations, and character development. *Class provided by Mode Music and Performing Arts.*

### **Scrapbooking**

**(All Ages, Max 8)**

Customize your own personal journal with memories of this week, and many more to come! Scrapbooking class will focus on creating fun and inspiring designs based on a weekly theme as well as mindful journaling.

### **Soccer Games**

**(Classes split by K-2<sup>nd</sup> Grade and 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> Grade, Max 20)**

Have fun playing pin down, soccer tag, scrimmaging and other soccer-type games with campers of all skill levels!

### **Song and Sound Making**

**(K-2<sup>nd</sup> Grade, Max 7; 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> Grade, Max 10)**

No matter your age or experience, the art of song and sound-making is a fun and fulfilling skill that you can use throughout your whole life. Join us as we explore the endless possibilities of SOUND. In this class we will develop our musical ear, learn to play music together with our friends, dance, play, experiment with new and unique percussion and string instruments, and ultimately create and record our own piece of music as a team. *Class provided by Attuned Music Lessons.*

### **Stamp Making**

**(4<sup>th</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> Grade, Max 14)**

Learn the art of designing, carving, and creating your own unique rubber stamps. Join us for a hands-on, journey into the world of stamp making. ***Learners will use sharp tools in this class.***

### **Story Drama**

**(K-2<sup>nd</sup> Grade, Max 10)**

Every class has its own story to tell! In the Story Drama series, students will use works by popular children's authors like Dr. Seuss and Eric Carle to explore the fundamentals of story-telling and work together to bring those stories to life. Students will have a blast using visuals, music, performance art, and games to create a unique "staged" version of each story. A final presentation of the students' creation will be performed on the final day of class for an audience of family and friends. *Class provided by Mode Music and Performing Arts.*

### **Ukulele 101**

**(K-2<sup>nd</sup> Grade, Max 10; 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> Grade, Max 12)**

Come learn ukulele with us! Whether you've played before or have never picked one up, our group ukulele class gives students the opportunity to learn an instrument that they can take with them anytime, anywhere. Basic knowledge of the instrument is introduced while learning to tune, strum, and read tablature and chord charts. We will also learn about the cultural significance and history of the ukulele. Students will leave this class being able to pick out simple, familiar melodies and play a handful of basic chords that can be used to play hundreds of songs! On the final day of class, students will have the opportunity to share what they've learned with friends and family by performing a showcase of selected songs. Participants may bring their own instrument, rent (\$15) or purchase (\$30) a Ukulele from Mode Music. *Class provided by Mode Music and Performing Arts.*

### **World Dance**

**(K-2<sup>nd</sup> Grade, Max 14)**

Children will experience a variety of music and dance styles that may include Guinean and other African dance, Hip Hop, Hawaiian Hula, Bhangra & Bollywood, Balinese, Brazilian, Armenian & Greek Folk, Cuban and more. Elements of Creative Dance and Movement are combined with cultural dances in each class. Stories, books, photos, videos, songs, instruments and dress-up related to the cultural dances being studied are often a part of the children's cultural experience. *Class provided by World Dance with Marissa.*

### **Young Engineers**

**(Classes split by 1<sup>st</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup> Grade and 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> Grade, Max 14)**

Engage in the theoretical and applied knowledge in the fields of Science, Technology, Mechanical Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM). The main goal is to illustrate content through stories and demonstrations. Students will learn mathematics and physical principles through intuitive study, develop their independent learning, and improve their building skills. Once the concepts have been demonstrated, students enjoy hands on model building, which provides experiential learning and reinforces the lessons. This unique curriculum teaches to topics of transmission, centrifugal force and centripetal force, speed, increasing/speed decreasing transmissions, symmetry, and the principle of inertia to name a few. *Class provided by Seattle Young Engineers.*
