## Chess Club with ChessMates

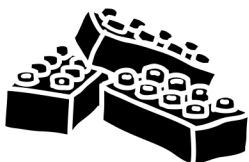
Grades: 1st - 5th. Minimum students: 8, Maximum Students: 14. Cost: \$155

Grades: K - 2nd. Minimum students: 7, Maximum Students: 16. Cost: \$231



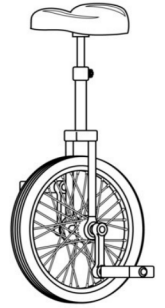

Grades: K - 2nd. Minimum students: 8, Maximum Students: 15. Cost: \$210

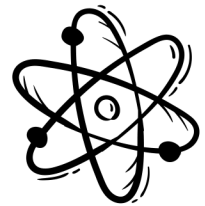

We'll witness the enormous power of tiny electrons, reveal how magicians use science to create astounding illusions, examine the four forces of flight, experiment with gravity, inertia and centripetal force, and uncover how these and other forces affect everything from buildings, to water, to the air around us.



## Pokémon Trainers League with Math n Stuff

Pokémon is a card game in which two players take on the role of Pokémon trainers, attempting to outwit and outplay each other using different Pokémon creatures and tactics in the arena. This after-school Pokémon class teaches the basic rules of the Pokémon Trading Card Game! Our young Pokémon trainers will get their own trainer decks to duel their friends. They will add new cards to their decks as they learn deeper strategies and the spirit of the game.
